| 9.45 – 10.30 | Morning tea |
| 10.30 – 11.30 | Play-based learning – Educators will provide a range of planned and spontaneous experiences including tummy time and sensory play |
| 11.30-12.00 | Group time – Educators will gather children in a planned experience which may include dance, songs, storytelling |
| 12.00-12.30 | Lunchtime |
| 12.30 – 2.00 | Sleep time |
| 2.00 - 2.30 | Afternoon tea |
| 2.30 -5.00 | Play-based learning – Educators will provide a range of planned and spontaneous experiences including reading stories, dance and songs |
| 5.00 - 6.30 | Transition to family grouping / Late snack |
